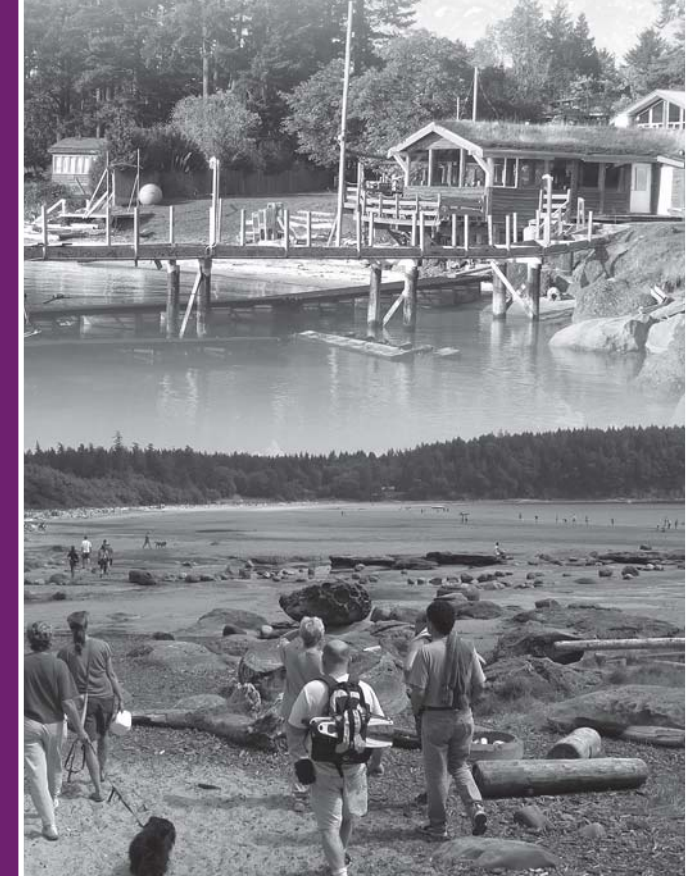

SOME ISLAND "GROUND RULES"

Help "preserve and protect" the environment of these islands.

Camping and cooking fires are permitted only in designated areas. Forest closures and prohibitions against beach fires are strictly enforced during high fire hazard times. Hazard conditions are prominently posted. Red cement blocks (and other signage) on a beach indicate shellfish leases. Avoid these areas, particularly at low tide, as walking on them can destroy young shellfish and do not harvest oysters or clams. (A license is required to pick on unmarked shorelines.)

The roads on these islands are narrow and winding. Please observe the speed limit, drive carefully, and always be on the lookout for others who share the roads with you... pedestrians, cyclists, joggers, horseback riders, and other cars. Canadian laws still apply on the islands. It is illegal to remove anything from beaches. Please look, learn and leave. Drinking alcohol in public, including beaches, is also illegal.

Cars must be at the terminal 3 minutes (passengers 5 minutes) prior to departure.

Fares: Customers travelling from Vancouver Island are requested to pay their Hornby Island fare at Buckley Bay. Credit cards are accepted at Buckley Bay, cash only at Gravelly Bay. To enhance service, extra sailings may be added and sailing times altered during heavy traffic periods. Low clearance vehicles (such as Low Beds, buses and some RVs) may be unable to travel during extreme tides. Please contact 1 888 BCFERRY when making travel plans. Travelling across Denman Island to catch the Hornby Island Ferry? Relax and enjoy the ride across Denman, there's plenty of time to make the next sailing to Hornby Island. Weekdays (except Friday) the last ferry from Vancouver Island that makes a connection to Hornby Island is 6pm. On Fridays this changes to 10pm.

Hornby & Denman Islands are beautiful places to visit year round. Beaches, lodging, artisan galleries and more are here for you to enjoy.



Many island beaches feature spectacular sandstone formations, sandy beaches and tide pools teeming with life.

Welcome to our Islands!

Nestled against the east coast of Vancouver Island, our Islands are home to communities of thoughtful, creative, diverse people who value the rural serenity and security of these islands. Spend a day exploring the forests and shorelines and you will understand why our communities are so passionate about the preservation and protection of these fragile ecosystems.

You can swim, kayak and sunbathe in warm weather, and in any weather enjoy hiking, cycling, bird watching and fishing. Take the opportunity to visit the many year-round artisans' studios, browse the stores for books, gifts, and edibles, or just relax at your lodgings. Both islands have craft fairs; market days, ongoing community school classes and excellent concerts and theatre productions.

Denman and Hornby Islands have many walking and hiking trails plus easy access to the beaches. Like many rural areas, the roads are winding and narrow; pedestrians, cyclists, horseback riders and deer have to share them with cars, so please observe the speed limit and drive carefully. You might want to come by bicycle to avoid long summer ferry line-ups.

Denman Island

Denman Village, a short walk from the ferry dock, is the hub of Island activities. This friendly neighbourhood consists of a community school offering kids summer programs, two community halls (one with an excellent theatre), a library, church, general store, bookstore, gift shop, bakery and a hardware store. Local stores offer everything you could possibly desire: groceries, liquor, propane, gasoline, postal outlet, video rentals, deli food, and sundries. Three of our many B&B's are located within walking distance of 'Downtown', as is the year-round co-op craft outlet. As you tour the Island you will find numerous artisans' studios/galleries and more B&B's. (Check the map).

Arts Denman, the island's arts council, has a 24-year history and runs a number of world class arts programs. Concerts Denman presents a series of fall and winter performances in music, dance and theatre in the charming community hall

which boasts a concert Yamaha grand piano. The Summer Art Gallery opens its season in June with exceptional 2-week juried exhibitions by local artists. The Readers & Writers Festival brings together renowned authors for readings, workshops and evening cabarets July 13- 19 this year. The Denman Island Arts Centre is located in a cozy restored house in the heart of the village, built circa 1908. Year round workshops in visual arts and music are offered by professional instructors. The centre is also home to exhibitions, studio groups, classes, film nights and special events. Visit www.artsdenman.com for a closer look, for a closer look.

Take time to visit the Saturday markets at the Recycling Depot where local artists, farmers, and gardeners display an intriguing range of goods for sale.

Boyle Point Provincial Park: this seaside day use park is located at the very south end of Denman. Follow the trails through old growth Douglas fir and watch for eagles and sea lions as you look over Eagle Rock and the lighthouse on Chrome Island.

Fillongley Provincial Park: This 80-acre park, on the east side of Denman Island, features an unspoiled sand and shell beach and fabulous views of Texada Island and the snow capped mainland Coast Mountain range. The miles-long foreshore is backed by an impressive stand of old growth Douglas and Grand Fir and Red Cedar trees. Follow the trail for an easy half-hour circuit or spend the day beachcombing. There are ten campsites available here and all facilities are wheelchair accessible.

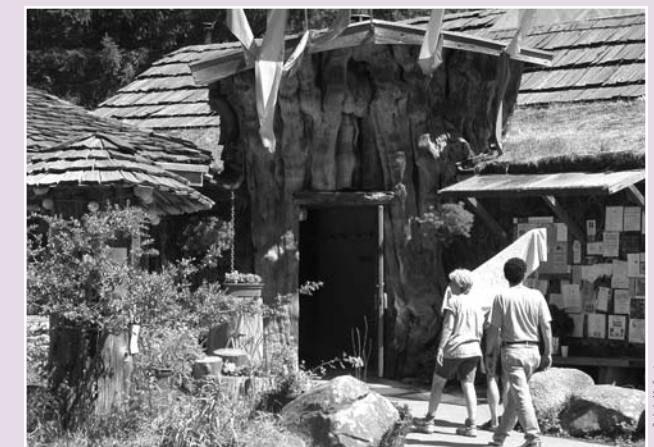
Hornby Island

As you drive off the ferry in the summer you will be welcomed by the Visitors Information Centre located at the Thatch Pub & Restaurant (also liquor store and laundromat). Along the main road you will encounter the Island Gallery showcasing local art work. Not far beyond, the Cardboard House includes a bakery, pizzeria, cappuccino bar, clothing and crafts shop and twice-weekly music events all summer. The hand-crafted Community Hall showcases dances, movies, festivals and art shows. Nearby are the Arts Resource Centre, the Clinic, the Computer Access Centre, the Natural History Exhibit (at the Community School) and the Library (at New Horizons). Local produce and crafts are on offer at the Farmers' Market, held throughout the summer each Wednesday and Saturday morning. A variety of social events and recreational opportunities happen year round, including at Joe King Park. For a special Hornby experience, visit the renowned Recycling Depot and Free Store.

A focal point of the Island is the large Co-op store and adjacent Ringside Market which includes cafes, stores, craft vendors, an outdoor recreation shop and the famous annual Hornby Island Quilt plus a nursery/eatery across the road. The Gas Bar is also in this location. Continuing down Central Road will take you to Ford's Cove where you will find the community dock, boat rentals, general store, dive shop, art gallery, pizza and fish and chips. Heading in the other direction towards Helliwell Park will take you past the turn-off to Sea Breeze Lodge which offers fine dining. Visit one of the many open studios and galleries around the island to experience the rich creativity of Hornby and take in the tasting rooms at our local wineries and meadery.

We invite you to help us steward this wonderful but fragile place. If we all slow down, conserve water and be respectful of our footprint, the Island will flourish for us for years to come.

We also invite you to come back in the spring, fall or winter to fully experience the peace, beauty and character of the Island. There is much to enjoy: the Blues Festival, the herring run, sea-lion migrations, spring wildflowers and a variety of community events.

Tribune Bay Provincial Park: This park boasts one of the best family beaches in BC with warm water and white sand beach. It is a safe place to swim, wade, explore tidal pools and play on the beach. Dogs are not allowed on the beach. There is a day-use picnic shelter but no overnight camping. Boaters are advised to not dump sewage or speed in the bay. The park is also the home of the Tribune Bay Outdoor Education Centre offering year-round school and youth programs.

Helliwell Provincial Park: This day-use park offers a five kilometre walk that circles along spectacular bluffs and through old-growth forest. This is an environmentally sensitive area. Please stay on the marked paths to avoid damage to rare plants adapted to the cliff-top habitat and keep dogs on a leash at all times to avoid disturbance of wildlife.

Mount Geoffrey Escarpment Park: This 187 hectare park contains several hiking/biking trails which connect to the extensive trail system extending over the mountain. The most popular trail runs from Ford's Cove to the ferry terminal.

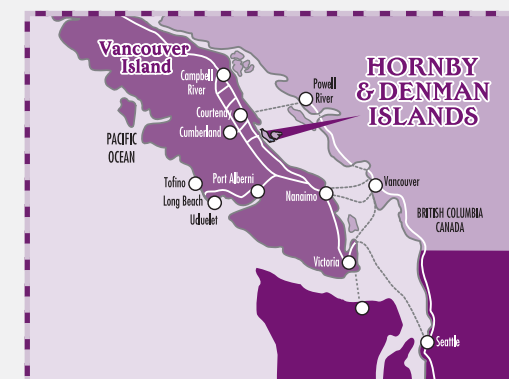
